PART II: AGREEMENT

SCRIPTURE: HABAKKUK 2:2-4; PROVERBS 16:9

key theme: I've got a vision, now what?

- 1) In order to walk according to a vision, we have to recognize who needs to partner with us and build agreement.
- 2) Agreement is harmony of opinion, action, or character by distinct entities
- 3) Vision requires 3 levels of prioritized agreement.
- 4) Agreement with God
 - a. Requires us to: 1) release our will to his will; 2) have our garden of Gethsemane experiences; + 3) Grow in the knowledge of his character and nature.
- 5) Agreement with Ourselves
 - a. Requires us to 1) evaluate and be honest about our present condition + 2) Be strengthened in our inner man
- 6) Agreement with Others
 - a. It requires us to 1) Evaluate the necessary parties and the role of each of those parties in the vision; 2) Understand that the vision will always be tested; + 3) Understand that God is refining the vision and plan within us.

- 3) How can you deal with the people who are not in agreement with the vision? Are they necessary, invested parties?
